

How to comment on a paper

<p>Feedback ?</p> <p>Add</p>	<p>Comment to individual student / paper: Click on "Add" in the row with the student's name.</p>
<p>My feedback</p> <p>Close Save</p>	<p>In the pop-up window: Type in the "Feedback" box. Complete commenting by clicking on "Save" (bottom right). You may edit the feedback later.</p>
<p>Feedback files</p> <p>Browse...</p>	<p>As part of the feedback you can upload a file with comments from your pc/Android tablet.</p>
<p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Share annotated PDF with student</p> <p>Are you sure?</p>	<p>If you have corrected the paper online in DE ("Read in browser"), you can share the annotated file with the student(s). Confirm sharing in the pop-up window.</p>
<p>Submit joint feedback</p>	<p>Comments to all students in the exam: Click on "Submit joint feedback", and follow the procedure described above (sharing of annotated file is not possible).</p>
	<p>Note: Feedback is shared with the students when the grade(s) have been submitted. Students must log on to DE to access the feedback.</p>

<p>My notes</p> <p>Close Save</p>	<p>In the pop-up window: Type in the box "My notes". Complete making notes by clicking on "Save" (bottom right).</p>
<p>Note files</p> <p>Browse...</p>	<p>You can also upload a file with comments from your pc/Android tablet.</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> Share my notes with co-examiners</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Share my annotated PDF with co-examiners</p>	<p>Click in the box to share notes with the co-examiner(s). If you have corrected the paper online in DE ("Read in browser"), you can share the annotated file with the co-examiner(s).</p>
